It's time. We've been collecting notebook entries all semester—quick thoughts on videos, poems, readings, visuals/pictures, reactions & responses. Show Mrs. C what you've got and talk about how it went.

Make a video on Flipgrid (visit [Flipgrid.com](https://flipgrid.com) and enter your class code—then find the Topic labeled "Notebook Tours") to showcase your notebook accomplishments. Include the following:

- # of entries – quick page through, show where they begin, end, etc.
- Flag a couple of your best/favorite entries and point them out
- What did you learn/discover through participating in quickwrites?
- Who or what are you writing for? Has the way you think about this changed?
- What (if anything) surprised you along the way?
- What are you most proud of?
- Share something—a few lines, an entire entry, a piece of your notebook thinking that you feel is particularly noteworthy for content or writing or just because.

You'll have no more than 10 minutes to talk about & show your writing. Yes, you'll need to be IN this video.* No, no one but Mrs. C will see it. (And it won't show after you upload since it's hidden from public view).

*If you are an MC Lit/English 5 student who kept a digital notebook, you can use the screencast feature in Flipgrid to show your screen while you talk me through your notebook thinking. Click – record a response – then use the 3 dot menu button to select "record screen" to screenshare.

IMPORTANT: THE NOTEBOOK TOUR IS A REQUIRED COMPONENT OF THIS COURSE. WITHOUT IT, YOU MAY SEE AS MUCH AS A LETTER GRADE'S REDUCTION OF YOUR FINAL SEMESTER GRADE.
